<u>Start Up Instructions:</u> Follow the below steps to Prime your Suntec pump on the ACF – 20 Gallon Sprayer. ***DO NOT RUN PUMP WITHOUT OIL – IT WILL SEIZE***

Step #1: Fill Honda GX120 4hp Engine with 10W-30 motor oil. Reference provided **Honda Engine Manual Page 8** for further recommendations. *Figure 1*



Step # 2: Remove 20 Gallon Tank Filler Cap and pour in Form Release until **END OF PICK UP TUBE is fully submerged** with form release in the tank. Insert Sprayer Wand into Tank and Open Valve on wand. *Figure 2*

STEP # 4: Prime Pump by removing the plug on top of pump with a 5/8" wrench. Fill pump with form release. Reinstall plug and tighten. Figure 3

STEP # 5: Start engine. Form Oil should start MISTING from wand within 15-20 seconds. IF NO MIST – SHUT DOWN. If wand IS MISTING your sprayer is ready. If not move to STEP #6



STEP # 6: Locate the bleeder valve (*figure 4.*) Open valve and start engine. Form Release should come out valve when engine is running. **Caution as the form release will spray rapidly from valve. ** Use a cup to catch form release. Figure 4

STEP # 7: Your sprayer should be operational – If not repeat STEPS #4 – 6.

Do not run pump without oil. Pump uses form release as a lubricant and will seize if form release isn't flowing through the pump. Any further issues call your local Advance Concrete Form, Inc. location for further information.
